VI: Targeted Intervention Plan

Mr. Niemeyer and Mrs. Patricia Glaeser, Testing Coordinator, presented a Targeted Intervention Plan and Needs Assessment Summary. The plan is used to identify root causes after the data analysis yields a summary of findings that result in a set of problem statements. The next step is to engage in the needs assessment process to identify the root causes following a 5 step assessment which include:

- Step 1: Clarify and Prioritize problem Statements
- Step 2: Establish the purpose of assessing root causes and establish the team
- Step 3: Gather Data
- Step 4: Data Analysis
- Step 5: Root cause analysis

The needs assessment process is intended to safeguard against planning or implementing strategies before the root cause of a problem is understood.
