I. Welcome

The May 2015 DEIC meeting began with a warm welcome to all present from Dr. Don Beck, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction, and reviewed the meeting agenda.

II. 2015-2016 District Improvement Plan

Dr. Beck opened the meeting with an explanation of the process to begin the No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Comprehensive Needs Assessment for 2015-16. It is a program that is part of the Performance-Based Monitoring (PBM) system that falls under the Texas Education Agency (TEA).
