##### I: Welcome and Call to Order

Mrs. Carla Voelkel, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction, welcomed everyone to the meeting.

##### II: 2013-14 Academic Calendar

Mrs. Carla Voelkel announced the results of the 2013-14 Academic Calendar district votes and calendar option A received the most votes. The results will be submitted to the school board at the February 19, 2013 meeting for approval.

##### III: District Corrective Action for School Improvement

Ella Moreaux, Federal Programs Director, reviewed the District Snapshot completed by Region IV and the School Improvement workbook.

##### IV: NCLB District Report Card

- Elementary Science - Amber Logan, Junior High Science - Kelly Coats, Secondary Science - Cindi Ollis
- Elementary Social Studies, none in elementary, Junior High Social Studies - Kelly Coats, Secondary World Geography - Cedric LePeuch.
