II: Accountability Performance Index Framework

Mrs. Voelkel provided a copy of a letter from Commissioner of Education, Michael L. Williams explaining the components of the 2013 accountability system.

The letter states that the revised accountability system for school districts in Texas will still use student assessments, but also will use additional indicators to provide parents and taxpayers greater detail on the performance of a school district. The four areas that will be included in the performance index framework are:

- Student Achievement
- Student Progress
- Closing Performance Gaps
- Postsecondary Readiness

Mrs. Voelkel reviewed the staggered terms of committee membership for 2013-2014, and the committee representatives selected Soviet Threatt to remain as chairperson. DEIC goals for 2013-2014 were updated, and the CNA/DIP timeline was reviewed.
