

Crenshaw Elementary Parent - School Compact 2018-2019



The following responsibilities are agreed upon by Crenshaw Elementary staff, students, and parents in order to maintain a positive working relationship that strives for student success and academic achievement.

Communication:

Students will:

- Write information and assignments in folder/agenda each day to share with parents daily
- Return forms and homework to school when it is due

Parents will:

- Check folder/agenda daily - read, sign and return documents as needed
- Communicate with the teacher first for concerns, questions, and complaints
- Respect confidentiality and do not share individual situations with other parents, neighbors, etc.
- Update school immediately with changes in address, phone numbers, emergency pick up list, custody issues, etc

Staff will:

- Ensure that important information is sent home in Wednesday folders
- Check folder/ agenda daily for parent signature
- Make contact with parents on a regular basis through notes, phone calls, email, class dojo, etc
- Respond to parent calls/notes within 2 days, or sooner if urgent
- Respect confidentiality of student information and do not share with staff members not directly involved with student

Academics

Students will:

- Complete and turn in their own work, including classwork and homework in the time expected
- Ask for make-up work when returning from an absence

Parents will:

- Establish daily routines for homework and completing paperwork
- Review homework, read with students, and practice skills needed to enhance classroom learning each day
- Contact teacher with questions or concerns
- Make every attempt to get students to school every day

Staff will:

- Explain homework, write assignments in the same place each day, and remind students of expectation
- Cover all skills expected for the grade level and subject
- Send a 9 weeks skill report at the start of each period listing concepts and skills that will be covered, and report student progress on specific skills and content

Behavior / Safety

Students will:

- Follow ALL school and classroom rules at all times
- Pay attention to instruction
- Treat others with respect

Parents will:

- Follow up with behavior problems and support positive school behavior
- Bring ID when visiting and follow procedures with transportation changes and visitors
- Be familiar with crisis plan and keep contact information updated

Staff will:

- Post rules and consequences
- Review rules and consequences with students
- Make crisis plan and safety procedures available to parents online and in the front office
