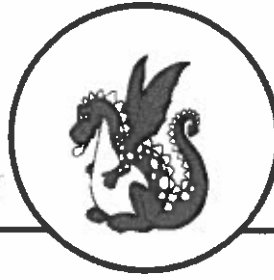

In fact, our campus administrators and teachers engage in activities on a regular basis to prepare students and teachers to react to emergency situations. We have included a flyer that details some key terms relating to safety procedures in place on all campuses. Our staff and students are trained annually on these procedures, and drills are practiced monthly and semi-annually depending on type of drill. Lockdown, Lockout, Evacuate, and Shelter are examples of procedures that are taught and practiced by students and staff throughout each year. In this way, we strive to ensure all students and staff members are educated and prepared to react to situations such as fires, weather emergencies, and even active shooters on campus. In the event of an emergency, the actions and appropriate directions listed on the included flyer will be called on the PA system. Please take a moment to review these actions with your child to reinforce these directions.
